Prizes are \$3,000, \$2,000 & \$1,000 for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place chapters to be deposited into the chapter fund of their choice.


Chapter Advisor Training

 - Drug & Alcohol Abuse
- Spring Topic (choose 1):

 - General Insurance & Risk Management*
 - Criminal Liability & Basic Legal Concepts
 - Sexual Violence Prevention
 - Fire Prevention

 - Ritual
 - Fraternity Finances
 - Alumni Engagement and Alumni Associations
 - Constitution and Bylaws
 - Recruitment and Expansion
 - Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
