 - Be versed in all basic operation functions of the National Fraternity, the Phi Kappa Psi Foundation, and the Canonsburg Corporation



- Facilitate in-depth training and programming sessions with chapters, working with officers, members, volunteers, and university to address key issues
- Serve as a resource for your assigned colony regarding operational best practices, policies, and traditions of the fraternity and be able to educate stakeholders on how to improve.
- Actively participate in the National Fraternity's initiatives and programs
 - Participate in all National Programming
 - Serve as an active participant in all-staff office training and planning sessions when relevant
- Utilize online reporting and data collections for chapter information collection
 - Weekly reports will be sent to supervisor for feedback, action items, and general information regarding the colony
