

# 2025-26 MEMBERSHIP COSTS

This document outlines the billing structure, payment procedures, and important dates for Phi Kappa Psi chapters. Please review the payment methods based on your chapter's LegFi status and note all billing deadlines to avoid late fees.

Additionally, pay close attention to your chapter's housing status, as Independently Housed Chapters and Corporation Housed Chapters have different per member rates due to varying Liability Insurance Premiums.

#### **PAYMENT INFORMATION**

Chapter billing contacts receive invoices and monthly account statements via email.

Chapters utilizing LegFi should submit payment via LegFi.

## 990 FILINGS

All chapters are required to file an annual return with the Internal Revenue Service at the end of their fiscal year. **All chapters on the LegFi platform are required to utilize OmegaFi's tax services for their annual return.** The required form will depend on the gross receipts and/or assets for each chapter.

Preparation fees as follows:

\$110 - Complete Form 990-N (Gross receipts normally < or = to \$50,000)

\$180 – Complete Form 990-T (Report any unrelated business income)

**\$285** – Complete Form 990-EZ (Gross receipts < \$200,000 and total assets < \$500,000)

**\$500** – Complete Form 990 (Gross receipts > or = to \$200,000 or total assets > or = to \$500,000), plus \$125 per hour for any mutually agreed upon extraordinary time spent compiling the Form.

**\$1,000** – Complete Form 1024 (Application for Recognition of Exemption; used for any chapter whose exemption status has lapsed)

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## **APPENDIX: FEE & FINE EXPLANATIONS**

#### I. EXPLANATION OF FEES

**Fall/Spring Dues** help pay for the Fraternity's chapter service programs and operational costs.

**Canonsburg Assessment** provides member income to the Canonsburg Corporation, as outlined in Article XIV – Tax Assessments, Section 7 of the Phi Kappa Psi Constitution and Bylaws.

**First Term Dues** are charged to all first term members in place of the Fall or Spring Dues. Dues collected contribute to chapter service programs, general operational costs, and liability insurance coverage.

**New Member Fees** cover the cost of new member education materials, which are accessible through the Phi Psi Portal. All fees and required information must be submitted to Headquarters within seven (7) days of the ceremony, in accordance with Article XIV – Tax Assessments, Section 1 (Pledge Fee), Clause 1 of the Phi Kappa Psi Constitution and Bylaws.

**Initiation Fees** cover the cost of the official badge, membership certificate, and membership card, which are sent to each initiated member. All fees and required information must be submitted to Headquarters within seven (7) days of the ceremony, per Article XIV – Tax Assessments, Section 2 (Initiation Fee), Clause 1 of the Constitution and Bylaws.

**Liability Insurance Premiums** provide liability coverage for the chapter and national fraternity. Additionally, theft coverage is provided for presidents and treasurers of both the chapter and house corporation. Independently Housed Chapters are charged \$95/member/census cycle, while Corporation Housed Chapters are charged \$118/member/census cycle.

#### II. EXPLANATION OF FINES

**Late Reporting Fines** are 10% per member reported more than seven (7) days after joining or initiation.

**Late Payment Fines** are 10% of the unpaid balance on all past due invoices.

**Returned Check/Payment Fines** are \$50 per occurrence and will result in the chapter being placed on LegFi.

Any chapter with a balance over 90 days past due will be reported to the Executive Council. The Executive Council will then begin the process to suspend the chapter until the outstanding balance is addressed.
